What is an Incident Command System (ICS)?

- Too many people reporting to one supervisor
- Different emergency response organizational structures
- Lack of reliable incident information
- Lack of best business practices
- Inadequate and incomplete information
- Lack of structure for coordinated planning among departments/agencies
- Unclear lines of authority
- Terminology differences among departments/agencies
- Unclear objectives among departments/agencies

ICS enables integrated communications and planning by establishing a manageable span of control. ICS divides emergency response into five manageable functions essential for emergency response operations:

1. Command
2. Operations
3. Planning
4. Logistics
5. Finance and Administration
